A delegation of powers under §48.979, Wis. Stats., involving an Indian child is not valid unless the parent’s consent is executed in writing, recorded before a judge, and accompanied by a judge’s written certification. If the Indian child does not have an underlying juvenile case, a Group Juvenile (GJ) case number should be assigned for this process.
