<b>Name of Form:</b>	<b>Affidavit of Clergy person to Waive Parental Consent for Abortion</b>
<b>Form Number:</b>	<b>JC-1621</b>

<b>Benchbook Reference:</b>	JV 15
<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	<p>A member of the clergy may file a "Petition to Waive Parental Consent for an Abortion," (JC-1620), on behalf of a pregnant juvenile. The clergy person must accompany the petition with an affidavit stating that certain statutory requirements have been complied with.</p> <p>Items 1 through 7 are required by statute. However, since the court may base its ultimate decision solely on the basis of the affidavit, item 8 was added as an optional question to provide additional information to the court.</p>
<b>Who Completes it:</b>	The clergy person who files the affidavit must complete it and have it notarized.
<b>Distribution:</b>	The original is filed with the Clerk of Circuit Court along with the petition. A copy is provided to the clergy person and a copy is served on the juvenile.
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	<p>This form must accompany the "Petition to Waive Parental Consent for an Abortion," (JC-1610), when a member of the clergy is filing the petition. It is not required when a pregnant juvenile is filing the petition on her own behalf.</p> <p>A juvenile who wants 24 hours notice of hearings, rather than immediate notice, may also have completed the "Waiver of Immediate Notice (Parental Consent/Abortion Waivers)," (JC-1622). If so, that form may be attached.</p>
<b>New Form/Modification:</b>	Modification, last update 7/96.
<b>Modifications:</b>	Added a file/date stamp to upper right corner. Added a statement on the bottom indicating that the form shall not be modified.
<b>Comments:</b>	None.
