Comments: This form is intended to be used in both chapter 48 and chapter 938

proceedings. There is no separate form number for chapter 48.

Pursuant to ASFA Final Rules, judicial determinations must be explicitly documented and made on a case by case basis. The order must contain the child-specific reasons for the court's decision. Reference simply to state statute to substantiate judicial determinations are not sufficient. Affidavits and *nunc pro tunc* orders are not acceptable to support

determinations related to out-of-home placements.

Pursuant to the requirements of the Federal Indian Child Welfare Act and accompanying regulations of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the court must make inquiry on the record in all cases whether any party has reason to believe that the child is an Indian child. The responses shall be recorded in the record. Additionally, the court must order the parties to disclose any such belief, should additional information become available.

A separate order must be completed for each child/juvenile.

RMC recommends that the court not rely upon attachments alone as the basis for its findings. Where attachments are used, specific reference to

the document title, page and paragraph should be made.
