Benchbook Reference:

Purpose of Form: The formal order signed by the court directing the custody ordered by the court for a child/juvenile.

Who Completes It: Court, district attorney or corporation counsel. The Court (Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner) signs this form.

Distribution of Form: Court, Child's/Juvenile's *Guardian ad Litem*/Adversary Counsel, Parents, Parents' Attorney(s), Child's/Juvenile's Guardian/Legal Custodian, District Attorney/Corporation Counsel, and Caseworker.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 05/24.

Modifications: Added denied and granted options under court orders; grouped the out-of-home placement findings together under 3A and 3B; moved name and address placement box from the bottom of order to #2A and #2B.

Comments: This form is intended to be used in both chapter 48 and chapter 938 proceedings. There is no separate form number for chapter 48.

Pursuant to ASFA Final Rules, judicial determinations must be explicitly documented and made on a case-by-case basis. The order must contain the child-specific reasons for the court's decision. Reference simply to state statute to substantiate judicial determinations are not sufficient. Affidavits and *nunc pro tunc* orders are not acceptable to support determinations related to out-of-home placements.

Pursuant to the requirements of the Federal Indian Child Welfare Act and accompanying regulations of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the court must make inquiry on the record in all cases whether any party has reason to believe that the child is an Indian child. The responses shall be recorded in the record. Additionally, the court must order the parties to disclose any such belief, should additional information become available.

A separate order must be completed for each child/juvenile.

The Records Management Committee recommends that the court not rely upon attachments alone as the basis for its findings. Where
