Purpose of Form: Give notice to interested persons of the scheduling of court proceedings.

Who Completes It: Juvenile court clerk or judicial assistant.

Distribution of Form: Original to court, copies for juvenile, juvenile's attorney, district attorney/corporation counsel, parent/guardian/legal custodian, and other interested parties. If applicable to foster parent/treatment foster parent/physical custodian.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 08/10.

Modifications: 2011 WI Act 181, permanency goal and hearing language.

Comments: This form is intended to be used in both ch. 48 and ch. 938 matters.

Previous modifications: Where appropriate, the word "child" has been changed to "child/juvenile" to reflect statutory language in chs. 48 and 938.

The signature line has also been removed since the notice is not a court order and is generally not signed.
