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**Name of Form:** Notice Concerning Grounds to Terminate Parental Rights

**Form Number:** JD-1753

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**Statutory Reference:** §§48.356, 48.415, and 938.356, Wisconsin Statutes

**Benchbook Reference:** JV 8, 11 & 13

**Purpose of Form:** To provide the notice to a parent or expectant mother of the possible grounds for termination of parental rights when a child or expectant mother or juvenile is placed outside the home or a parent is denied visitation rights.

**Who Completes It:** Court

**Distribution of Form:** Original to parent(s) or expectant mother

**Accompanying Forms:** Generally none.

**New Form/Modification:** Modification, last update 08/08.

**Modifications:** Removed the “substantial likelihood” requirement from the Continuing Need for Protection or Services ground for TPR cases, except those cases where the child has been placed out-of-home for less than 15 of the last 22 months. 2017 WI Act 256, which went into effect on 4/6/18.

**Comments:** This form should be completed and the court should orally inform in court the parent(s) or expectant mother of the applicable grounds every time a child or expectant mother or juvenile is placed outside the home or a parent is denied visitation rights under a judgment that a child/unborn child/juvenile is in need of protection or services or delinquent under §§48.345, 48.347, 48.357, 48.363, 48.365, 938.34, 938.345, 938.357, 938.363, or 938.365 and whenever the court reviews a permanency plan under §48.38(5m) or §938.38(5m). A copy of the form must be attached to any such order.
