Purpose of Form: Request to the court to enter an order changing placement, revising the dispositional order, extending the dispositional order, reviewing the permanency plan and/or terminate consent decree/dispositional order.

Who Completes It: Caseworker, district attorney, corporation counsel, or other party requesting the change and/or hearing.

Distribution of Form: Court file, child/juvenile and attorney, parents/guardian/ legal custodian/attorney, case worker, physical custodian, district attorney/corporation counsel, and guardian ad litem.

Accompanying Forms: Additional documentation justifying the request may be attached if the space provided in the form is insufficient. If this is a request for a permanency plan review hearing, a copy of the plan must be filed 5 days prior to the review hearing or attached to this document.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 05/18.

Modifications: Changed form title. Added option to terminate consent decree. Added §§48.32 and 938.32 in footer.

Comments: This form is to be used in both ch. 48 and ch. 938 matters. Removed "Consent Decree" from #3; form JD-1800 should be used to request extension of a consent decree.
