Purpose of Form:	Affidavit and motion requesting that sanctions be imposed on a juvenile.
Who Completes It:	District attorney, corporation counsel or worker.
Distribution of Form:	Original to court, copies to juvenile and juvenile's parent/guardian/legal custodian
Accompanying Forms:	Generally none
New Form/Modification:	Modification, last update 04/08.
Modifications:	Added Indian Child Welfare Act language. Removed affidavit from form title and deleted all references to affidavit as well as the notary requirements as they are not statutory.
Comments:	If the motion requests secure detention or any form of out of home placement on the juvenile, the moving party must complete paragraph 5. The motion must include a statement whether the juvenile is subject to the federal Indian Child Welfare Act, 25 USC §§1901-1963. A paragraph has been added to cover this situation.
