<b>Name of Form:</b>	<b>Stipulation for Consent Decree (In-Home Placement Only)</b>
<b>Form Number:</b>	<b>JD-1784A</b>
<b>Statutory Reference:</b>	§§48.32 and 938.32, Wisconsin Statutes
<b>Benchbook Reference:</b>	JV 6
<b>Purpose of Form:</b>	To record an agreement between the parties requiring certain actions or activities to be done in exchange for suspending formal proceedings. The court official approves the consent decree and orders the parties to comply with it.
<b>Who Completes It:</b>	Generally one of the interested parties in the proceedings for presentation to the court official for approval and signing.
<b>Who Signs It:</b>	<b>BY THE COURT:</b> Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner.
<b>Distribution of Form:</b>	Original to court, copies to those who signed the consent decree and any service providers.
<b>Accompanying Forms:</b>	Generally none.
<b>New Form/Modification:</b>	Modified; last update 08/12.
<b>Modifications:</b>	Added an option for amending a Consent Decree. See 2015 WI Act 373.
<b>Comments:</b>	Split for eFiling, 05/16.  This consent decree is only to be used for in-home placements. For out-of-home placements under a consent decree use form JD-1785, Consent Decree (Out-of-Home Placement Only).  RMC recommends that the court not rely upon attachments alone as the basis for its findings. Where attachments are used, specific reference to the document title, page and paragraph should be made.
