Name of Form: Letters of Guardianship and Dispositional Order Appointing Guardian (Full/Limited/Temporary Guardianship) (§48.9795, Wis. Stats.)

Statutory Reference: §§48.9795, Wisconsin Statutes, 25 U.S.C. §1915.

Benchbook Reference:

Purpose of Form: To appoint a full, limited, or temporary Guardian of the child and issue Letters of guardianship and dispositional order appointing guardian.

Who Completes It: Court (Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner). **This is a final order for the purpose of appeal.**

Distribution of Form: Court; copies to the child – if 12 years or older, child’s parents, child’s Guardian, child’s Legal Custodian, child’s *Guardian ad Litem*/Adversary Counsel, and any Additional Interested Persons.

Accompanying Forms:

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 05/24.

Modifications: Fixed a typo in the lettering 1C – 1G under Court Orders.

Comments: To order Minor Guardianship of the Estate, use GN-3330.

For an Indian child, use the Indian Child Welfare Act version – IW-1530.

For Dispositional Order Appointing an Emergency Guardian, use form JN-1521.

The court may appoint co-guardians of the person for a child, subject to any conditions that the court imposes. Unless the court orders otherwise, any decision concerning the child must be concurred in by all co-guardians or is void. Wis. Stat. §48.9795 (2)(b)(4). If co-guardians are ordered, both names shall be included on the order.
