Name of Form: Notice of Summary Proceeding Deadline (Formal Administration)

Form Number: PR-1826

Statutory Reference: Ch. 867, Wis. Stats.

Purpose of Form: To give notice of the court established deadline to complete a summary proceeding.

Who Completes It: Register in Probate.

Who Signs It: **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner/Register in Probate. **THIS IS A FINAL ORDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPEAL IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.**

Distribution of Form: Court; copies to Petitioner, special administrator or attorney, if any.

Accompanying Forms: Generally none.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 10/10.

Modifications: In a formal proceeding, Register in Probate can sign but Probate Registrar cannot.

Comments: This is a **CCAP only** form.

Since probate estates under full administration must be completed promptly, a summary proceeding should likewise be promptly completed.
