**Purpose of Form:** To give notice of the court established deadline to complete a summary proceeding.

**Who Completes It:** Register in Probate.

**Who Signs It:** **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner/Register in Probate. **THIS IS A FINAL ORDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPEAL IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.**

**Distribution of Form:** Court; copies to Petitioner, special administrator or attorney, if any.

**Accompanying Forms:** Generally none.

**New Form/Modification:** Modified; last update 10/10.

**Modifications:** In a formal proceeding, Register in Probate can sign but Probate Registrar cannot.

**Comments:** This is a CCAP only form.

Since probate estates under full administration must be completed promptly, a summary proceeding should likewise be promptly completed.
