Modifications:	Added remote notary statement pursuant to 2019 WI Act 125.
Comments:	Expanded file stamp/date area to 3" x 3" to accommodate the Register in Deeds statutory requirement for recorded documents (09/16). Can be used in place of deeds to records transfer by virtue of probate to interested persons.
