Name of Form: Affidavit of Service of SC-500, Summons and Complaint Individual/Sole Proprietorship/Partnership Non-Eviction (Small Claims)

Form Number: SC – 5120V

Statutory Reference: §§801.11 and 801.14, Wisconsin Statutes

Purpose of Form: To provide a document, signed under oath, by which a person who has served documents on an individual, or another person who is a sole proprietor or partner, can provide the necessary information concerning that service.

Who Completes It: The person who has formally served documents on a person fills out the information concerning the date and time of service and the documents served. That person then seeks out a notary public and, after being sworn, signs the document. The notary public will complete the notarial section.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court after it has been signed and notarized.

Accompanying Forms: The documents for which service is being made will be given to the process server along with a copy of this affidavit of service.

Modifications: Added remote notary statement pursuant to 2019 WI Act 125.
