Purpose of Form: To provide a document by which a plaintiff may request the court to vacate a dismissal, enter a judgment of eviction based upon noncompliance of a defendant(s), and issue a writ of restitution. The form also provides a document for the plaintiff to request a hearing to determine the amount of a money judgment against the defendant(s) or to enter a money judgment against the defendant(s).

Who Completes It: The plaintiff(s) or plaintiff's attorney.

Who Signs It: **BY THE COURT:** Circuit Court Judge/Circuit Court Commissioner.
THIS IS A FINAL ORDER FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPEAL IF SIGNED BY A CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE.

Distribution of Form: Original will be filed with the court after it has been signed and notarized.
