Name of Form:	Order Dismissing/Denying Petition for Temporary Restraining Order/Injunction
Form Number:	CV-409
Statutory Reference:	Chapter 48 and 813, Wisconsin Statutes
Benchbook Reference:	None.
Purpose of Form:	To deny a petition for injunction or to dismiss a temporary restraining order/injunction in domestic abuse, individual at risk, harassment, or child abuse actions.
Who Completes It:	The Court.
Distribution of Form:	Original to court, copy to petitioner, respondent, and law enforcement agency acting as repository for injunctions and Department of Justice (if an injunction has been previously granted and is now being vacated).
Accompanying Forms:	If the petitioner is requesting a dismissal, or the parties are stipulating to a dismissal, some document evidencing the request will usually be provided to the court and may be attached to the order.
New Form/Modification:	Modification; last update 02/11.
Modifications:	Removed “at or after injunction hearing” after court finds; removed “denying injunction” in title, added law enforcement to distribution.
Comments:	This form is to be used when a court official dismisses a temporary restraining order or an injunction: 1) At an injunction hearing; or 2) When a party requests a dismissal after an injunction has already been granted. This form should not be used as a dismissal order for dismissing or denying a temporary restraining order.
About this Form:	This form is the product of the Wisconsin Records Management Committee, a committee of the Director of State Court's Office and a mandate of the Wisconsin Judicial Conference.
