Name of Form: Petition for Termination of Parental Rights

Purpose of Form: To initiate a proceeding to terminate the parental rights of a parent.

Who Completes It: Party who is seeking the termination.

Distribution of Form: Original to court file, copies of the Summons and Petition are to be served on:

- parent or parents of child (unless parent has waived right to notice);
- unadjudicated father who has filed a declaration of interest;
- person who has lived in a familial relationship with child and may be the father;
- guardian, guardian ad litem, and legal custodian of child;
- child (if 12 years of age or older);
- any other person to whom notice is required under ch. 822, Wisconsin Statutes, excluding foster parents.
- child (if 12 years of age or older).

Accompanying Forms: If the space provided for reciting the facts and circumstances supporting the termination is insufficient, additional materials may be attached.

New Form/Modification: Modified; last update 09/14.

Modifications: Added, "Child has previously been adopted?" with yes and no check boxes. See 2015 WI Act 381. Added additional lines for mother/father to accommodate same sex couples.
