


**TEMPORARY AND EMERGENCY MEASURES FOR  
BROWN COUNTY SMALL CLAIMS CASES**

1. These Temporary and Emergency Measures for Brown County Small Claims Case are entered as an addendum to the Order Enacting Temporary Measures for Courthouse Operations Regarding COVID-19 Public Emergency entered by the Honorable Tammy Jo Hock on March 17, 2020 and the findings set forth there are incorporated herein. Please be advised that these measures apply to Brown County Small Claims Cases only.
2. These Temporary and Emergency Measures are subject to change and may be modified by further court order and/or further written notice based upon the evolving circumstances regarding the spread of COVID-19 and ongoing directives and recommendations from local, state and national governmental departments and/or agencies and the Court's calendar. It is highly recommended that all attorneys and parties continue to monitor this developing situation by visiting at: [www.wicourts.gov](http://www.wicourts.gov) and their individual case status through the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access website located at: [www.wcca.wicourts.gov](http://www.wcca.wicourts.gov).
3. This COVID-19 coronavirus health situation constitutes good cause to go beyond any applicable statutory time limits for the holding of a return date under Chapter 799 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
4. Please be advised of the following postponed and/or rescheduled small claims court activities:
  - a. Small claims cases that were scheduled for Courtroom B on Wednesday, March 18, 2020 at 1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. have been rescheduled to Wednesday, April 29, 2020 for the same time (1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. or 3:15 p.m.) and same location (Courtroom B).
  - b. Small claims cases, including eviction return dates, which are scheduled for Courtroom B on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 at 1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. have been postponed indefinitely. These matters will be rescheduled for a later date as the Court's calendar permits and parties will be advised of the new date via written notice.
  - c. Small claims cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Wednesday, March 25, 2020 at 1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. have been rescheduled to Monday, April 27, 2020 for the same time (1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. or 3:15 p.m.) and same location (Courtroom B).
  - d. Small claims replevin cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Fridays at 1:15 p.m. on the following dates: March 27, April 3, April 10 and April 17, 2020 have been rescheduled to May 1, 2020 at 1:15 p.m. in Courtroom B.
  - e. Garnishment hearings that are scheduled for Courtroom B at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, March 27, 2020 have been rescheduled to Friday, May 8, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. in Courtroom B.
  - f. Small claims cases, including eviction return dates, which are scheduled for Courtroom B on Tuesday, March 31, 2020 at 1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. have been postponed indefinitely. These matters will be rescheduled for a later date as the Court's calendar permits and parties will be advised of the new date via written notice.
  - g. Small claims cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Wednesday, April 1, 2020 at 1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. and 3:15 p.m. have been rescheduled to Monday, May 4 for the same time (1:15 p.m., 2:15 p.m. or 3:15 p.m.) and same location (Courtroom B).
  - h. Small claims cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 remain on the calendar as scheduled at this time.
  - i. Small claims cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Wednesday, April 8, 2020 remain on the calendar as scheduled at this time.

- j. Small claims cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Tuesday, April 14, 2020 remain on the calendar as scheduled at this time.
- k. Small claims cases that are scheduled for Courtroom B on Wednesday, April 15, 2020 remain on the calendar as scheduled at this time.
- l. Small claims cases that are scheduled for contested hearings on the following dates: Friday, March 27, 2020; Monday, March 30, 2020; Friday, April 3, 2020; Monday, April 6, 2020; Friday, April 10, 2020; Monday, April 13, 2020; Friday, April 17, 2020 and Monday, April 20, 2020 have been postponed indefinitely. These matters will be rescheduled for a later date as the Court's calendar permits and parties will be advised new date via written notice.
- m. Any parties with a pending case who have been ordered to mediation through the Mediation Center of Greater Green Bay are still required to appear on their scheduled mediation dates. Any questions regarding rescheduling or request to appear by telephone may be directed to (920) 438-7067.
