**IGNITION INTERLOCK**: Mandatory interlock for all alcohol concentration of .15 or more. License restricted to interlocked vehicles, plus all registered and titled vehicles (unless excepted) for period of one year to 18 months beginning when license issued. \$50.00 interlock surcharge

**ALCOHOL AND DRUG ASSESSMENT**: The Court shall order that the defendant submit to and comply with an assessment for the use of alcohol and drugs.

- 1. Court may order the safety plan to include effect on any victim or victim's family.
- 2. Court may order community service work that demonstrates adverse effects of abuse (and a reasonable fee).
- 3. Court may order a visit to a site that demonstrates adverse effects of abuse (and a reasonable fee).
- 4. **Court may,** after a finding of inability to pay, reduce the costs or forfeiture and order the person to pay the difference toward the cost of the alcohol assessment and driver safety plan.
