Schedule of Oral Argument

This document provides general information for attending oral arguments before the Wisconsin Supreme Court and includes a list of all potential argument dates during the Court's term, which extends from September through June. Please note that not every listed date will be utilized, as the Court's schedule is subject to change.

Oral Arguments are open to the public. To confirm whether a specific case is scheduled for argument on a given date, please contact the Office of the Clerk of the Supreme Court at (608) 266-1880.

Case-specific information is typically available 30 to 60 days before the scheduled hearing date and may be obtained through the Clerk's Office or on the Wisconsin Court System's website at wscca.wicourts.gov.

On days when oral arguments are held, the Court generally convenes at 9:00 a.m., 10:15 a.m., and 1:30 p.m. Members of the public wishing to attend should arrive at the Supreme Court Hearing Room – located in the East Wing of the State Capitol – approximately 15 minutes prior to start time. Seating is limited and available on a first-come, first serve basis.
