Williams v. Schroeder

On August 14, 2025, this court received a document from Mr. Clyde B. Williams that bears the following two notations near the top of the document: "This is a Formal Complaint File Against: Hon. Bruce E. Schroeder" and "Allegation of Misconduct: Authorization FroFor [sic] Review, [757.85[] & 757.91 & 757.89 This Complaint is under this sec Willful Violation of & a Persistent Failure to Perform Official Duties." The document appears to complain about Judge Bruce Schroeder's handling of Mr. Williams' criminal cases. Among the attachments to the document is a letter from the Executive Director of the Wisconsin Judicial Commission, declining to reconsider the Judicial Commission's decision dismissing Mr. Williams' misconduct claims against Judge Schroeder. The document does not contain any prayer for relief from the court. It does not, for example, ask that this court issue a supervisory writ, grant leave to commence an original action, or grant review of a decision of the court of appeals. Consequently, there is not a basis for construing the document as a petition asking this court to exercise either its original or appellate jurisdiction.

The statutes referenced by Mr. Williams relate to the operation of the Judicial Commission and to judicial discipline proceedings initiated by the Judicial Commission. The Supreme Court of Wisconsin does not have supervisory authority over the Judicial Commission, including its

decision to dismiss misconduct claims against a judge. Consequently, the court will take no action regarding the August 14, 2025 filing.

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action regarding the filing received from Mr. Clyde B. Williams on August 14, 2025.
