Johnson v. Hinchley, L.C.#2023CV83

On August 25, 2025, plaintiff-appellant, Deshawn D. Johnson, pro se, filed a document captioned "Notice of Intent to File a Petition for Review" in which he indicates his intent to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' decision dated July 10, 2025, which was followed by an order dated July 30, 2025, denying a timely motion for reconsideration. The court notes that the rules of appellate procedure do not contemplate the filing of a notice of intent to precede a petition for review. The court further notes that pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 808.10(2), the 30-day period in which to file a petition for review begins to run on the date that the court of appeals denies a timely motion for reconsideration. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the document captioned "Notice of Intent to File a Petition for Review" shall be deemed to be a timely, but non-conforming, petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court no later than September 30, 2025. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed.
