No. 2023AP1300-CR State v. McMath, L.C. #2015CF4511

On July 25, 2025, Robert C. McMath, through counsel, filed a petition for review of the court of appeals' July 1, 2025 decision in this matter. The State filed a response on July 31, 2025. On August 6, 2025, Mr. McMath, pro se, filed a letter with this court "request[ing] that this Court withdraw [the] petition for review, remove [counsel] from this case, and allow [McMath] to proceed pro se." On August 8, 2025, this court, by its clerk and commissioners, ordered that counsel for Mr. McMath inform the court as to the status of this matter and whether Mr. McMath intends to proceed with the petition for review filed in this matter.

On August 26, 2025, counsel for Mr. McMath filed a status report stating that "Mr. McMath confirmed to the undersigned in a phone conference on August 18, 2025, that he wishes to withdraw the petition for review filed on July 25, 2025, that he wishes to discharge the undersigned, and that he intends to proceed pro se in filing a petition for review." The status report further indicates that Mr. McMath asks this court for 30 days to file his pro se petition for review. The court construes the August 26, 2025 status report as a motion for counsel to withdraw and a motion for leave for Mr. McMath to file an amended petition for review, pro se.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion for counsel to withdraw is granted and counsel is hereby discharged from further representation of Robert C. McMath in this matter;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for leave to file an amended petition for review is granted. Robert C. McMath, proceeding pro se, shall have 30 days from the date of this order to file an amended petition for review that complies with the requirements of Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(2) & (4), which document will become the operative pleading in this matter; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(3), the State of Wisconsin shall file any response to the amended petition for review within 14 days after service of the amended petition for review.
