No. 2025XX1442-D Office of Lawyer Regulation v. Travis Schwantes

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) filed a notice of motion and motion, along with a supporting affidavit and exhibits, seeking the summary suspension of Attorney Travis Schwantes' license to practice law in Wisconsin pursuant to SCR 22.20. The motion is based on Attorney Schwantes' guilty pleas to, and subsequent convictions of, one felony count of making a false representation to qualify for assignment of counsel, as a party to a crime, and two misdemeanor counts of prostitution—nonmarital sexual intercourse in State v. Schwantes, Milwaukee County Case No. 2024CF5497.

On July 24, 2025, this court issued an order directing Attorney Schwantes to show cause, in writing, by August 13, 2025, why the OLR's motion for summary suspension should not be granted. On August 13, 2025, Attorney Schwantes, through counsel, filed a response to the motion, as well as a supporting affidavit and exhibits. On August 29, 2025, the OLR filed a reply in support of its motion.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted. The license of Attorney Travis Schwantes to practice law in this state is temporarily suspended as of the date of this order and until further notice of this court. He shall further comply with the requirements of SCR 22.26 relating to license suspension if he has not already done so.
