Johnson v. Hinchley, L.C.#2023CV83

By order of August 26, 2025, this court construed a filing by defendant-appellant, Deshawn D. Johnson, pro se, as a timely, but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of July 30, 2025. Mr. Johnson has not yet paid the filing fee for the petition or filed a petition for waiver of fees. By motion filed September 15, 2025, Mr. Johnson has asked for additional time to do so.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted. By September 30, 2025, Mr. Johnson must either pay the \$195.00 filing fee or show good cause for waiving the fee by filing the petition for waiver of fees that he has confirmed in his motion that he is in receipt of as of September 11, 2025. Mr. Johnson is reminded that, per this court's August 26, 2025 order, he must file a statement in support of his timely, but nonconforming petition for review by September 30, 2025, that complies with the requirements of Wis. Stat. (Rule) § 809.62(2) and (4). Failure to meet either of these deadlines is grounds for dismissal.
