On September 19, 2025, the parties filed a joint status report and joint stipulation in this judicial discipline matter. The parties have now stipulated to the factual allegations and conclusions of law as pleaded in the complaint, and they jointly assert "that a reprimand would be an appropriate sanction in this matter."
