Balsimo v. Venture One Stop, Inc., L.C. #2021CV540

The court of appeals issued a decision in this matter on September 4, 2024. Any petition for review needed to be filed with the clerk of this court within 30 days after the date of that decision; i.e., by October 4, 2024. See Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10(1), 808.62(1m). Because petitions for review do not meet the criteria for facsimile filing set forth in Wis. Stat. § 801.16, they may not be filed by facsimile.

On October 7, 2024, Nick Balsimo, pro se, filed via facsimile a document titled "Request for extension of Petition for Review Filing Deadline." In this document, Mr. Balsimo asks for a "1-5 business [day]" extension to the petition for review deadline.

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 365, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). In addition, the motion may not be construed as a timely but nonconforming petition for review, as it was not timely filed under Wis. Stat. §§ 808.10(1) and 809.62(1m), and it was filed by a method (facsimile) that is not permitted for petitions for review. See generally Wis. Stat. § 801.16. Without a timely, permissibly filed petition for review, this court lacks jurisdiction. See Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d at 264-65.
