Dear Ms. Fremgen:

The State of Wisconsin has received the petition for review filed by defendant-appellant-petitioner William J. Lee. Because the petition does not present any reasons satisfying the standards enunciated in Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62 for granting review, the State opposes the petition. This case does not present "special and important reasons" for supreme court review. Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.62(1r). There is no novel issue of law, lack of clarity or conflict of law which requires development, clarification or harmonizing by the supreme court. Mr. Lee seeks a review of the court of appeals' decision for correctness. That is not adequate justification for review. *See State v. Minued*, 141 Wis. 2d 325, 328, 415 N.W.2d 515 (1987).

The State will not file a formal written response unless the court orders one.
