The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

Plaintiff-appellant, Jessica Mabin, by counsel, moves to extend the time in which to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' decision dated September 25, 2025, and subsequent denial of a motion for reconsideration issued October 21, 2025. Mabin seeks until November 26, 2025, to file the petition for review.

As counsel should be aware, the 30-day period in which to file a petition for review is jurisdictional and may not be enlarged. *First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou*, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in order to preserve Mabin's appellate rights, the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely, but nonconforming petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of Wis. Stat. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by November 26, 2025. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition will be summarily dismissed. No further time extensions will be granted; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within five days of the date of this order, Mabin shall remit the required \$195.00 fee for filing a petition for review to the clerk of this court. Failure to do so will result in the petition being summarily dismissed.
