No. 2023AP1300-CR State v. McMath, L.C. #2015CF4511

On July 25, 2025, Robert C. McMath, through counsel, filed a petition for review of the court of appeals' decision in this matter. Thereafter, McMath requested to withdraw the petition for review, discharge counsel, and file an amended petition for review proceeding pro se. On August 27, 2025, this court granted those requests and gave McMath 30 days to file an amended petition for review. On September 18, 2025, this court granted McMath's pro se motion to extend the time to file his amended petition for review, giving him until November 28, 2025 to do so. That order further stated that "no further extensions will be granted."

On November 25, 2025, recently retained counsel for McMath filed a motion to extend the time to file Mr. McMath's amended petition for review until December 29, 2025, citing counsel's workload and recent retainer on the case. Given the admonition in this court's September 18, 2025 order, this court ordinarily would not look favorably upon yet another request for an extension of time—particularly since this matter has been pending since July, 2025. However, based on the assertions in counsel's motion, the court concludes that one final, modest extension is appropriate in this case, but it does not grant the full requested time. Therefore,
