No. 2020AP469-CRNM State v. Luis A. Curet, L.C. #2017CF1798

On December 8, 2025, respondent-appellant, Luis A. Curet, pro se, filed a document requesting an extension of time in which to file a petition for review. It appears from that document and the docket of Appeal No. 2024AP469-CRNM that Mr. Curet is seeking an extension of time to file a petition for review of the court of appeals' order of November 10, 2025, which denied Mr. Curet's second motion for reconsideration of its January 31, 2024 final opinion and order summarily affirming the judgment of convictions in State v. Curet, Waukesha County Case No. 2017CF1798. Mr. Curet's motion for an extension of time must be dismissed.

First, the subject of a petition for review must be the final decision of the court of appeals. In Interest of A.R., 85 Wis. 444, 270 N.W.2d 581 (1978). The final decision of the court of appeals in this matter was issued on January 31, 2024, and the record was remitted to the circuit court of March 12, 2024, which closed this appeal. The court of appeals' order denying Mr. Curet's second motion for reconsideration is not a final decision of the court of appeals from which a petition for review can be filed.

In addition, Mr. Curet's motion cannot be deemed to be a timely petition to review the court of appeals' final decision of January 31, 2024, or a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for review of that decision. A petition for review must be filed within 30 days after the date of the court of appeals' final decision. Mr. Curet's motion was filed long after the 30-day period following January 31, 2024, expired. Further, the 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979). Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the document filed on December 8, 2025, requesting an extension of time in which to file a petition for review is dismissed. The clerk of this court is instructed to place any additional filings from Mr. Curet in the closed file of this matter without response.
