The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On October 28, 2025, the court of appeals issued a decision affirming a circuit court order that denied Moche Lamar Greer's pro se motion for postconviction relief under Wis. STAT. § 974.06. Any petition for review of this decision was due 30 days thereafter, or within 30 days of the date of a court of appeals' ruling on a timely filed motion for reconsideration. Wis. STAT. §§ 808.10, 809.62(1m). Mr. Greer did not timely file a motion for reconsideration, so, given the Thanksgiving holiday, his petition for review was due on Friday, November 28, 2025. Mr. Greer did not file a petition for review by that date or any other; he has filed no petition for review whatsoever. Although by letter dated December 12, 2025, the State of Wisconsin forwarded the court a copy of a petition for review that it had received from Mr. Greer, the court's receipt of that copy does not make up for the absence of a timely filed petition for review from Mr. Greer himself. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on the copy of the petition for review enclosed with the State's December 12, 2025 letter to the court. The court lacks jurisdiction in this matter.
