The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On December 22, 2025, Jason A. Olrich, pro se, filed a document titled "Motion to Appeal to Wisconsin Supreme Court" in this miscellaneous appeal matter, relating to Kenosha County Case No. 2022CT120, in which Olrich is charged with various criminal traffic offenses. Court records indicate that there is a motion hearing scheduled in that case for February 19, 2026.

In his filing in this court, Olrich alleges: that his right to due process has been violated due to non-preservation of evidence; that his right to counsel has been violated; that the presiding judge and prosecuting attorney have engaged in various forms of misconduct; that prison officials have interfered with his access to the court; and that Kenosha County officials have refused to investigate his criminal allegations against the presiding judge and prosecuting attorney.

On December 8, 2025, the court of appeals issued an order taking no action on various motions that Olrich filed that initiated this miscellaneous appeal proceeding.

Olrich's December 22, 2025 filing before this court does not seek review of a final decision of the court of appeals, and there is no appeal presently pending in the underlying circuit court case. Accordingly, there is no basis for this court to exercise its jurisdiction in this miscellaneous appeal matter. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on Olrich's December 22, 2025 filing.
