The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On January 2, 2026, Luke Albert Joseph, pro se, filed a document with the clerk of this court setting forth a "Claim of Injury" and directing various state and county officials to "Take Final Notice" of an incident that occurred on December 21, 2021, where Joseph was allegedly removed from a Waushara County Board meeting for failure to comply with a county mask mandate. Joseph further alleges that he was unlawfully arrested for attending a county board meeting the following January.

The document does not identify any pending circuit court or court of appeals case to which it relates. Additionally, the document does not seek any relief from this court or otherwise purport to invoke this court's original jurisdiction. Further, the document was not accompanied by any filing fee or indigency fee waiver forms. Accordingly, there is no basis upon which this court could exercise jurisdiction. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that this court will take no action with respect to Joseph's January 6, 2026 filing; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court is directed to close this miscellaneous proceeding.
