The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On December 9, 2025, this court issued an order, which noted that the brief and supplemental appendix of respondent-respondent, Attorney Mary Jo Brooks Hunter, had not been served within the time required by Wis. Stat. § (Rule) 809.19 and § (Rule) 809.82. The order further directed that respondent-respondent's brief (and supplemental appendix, if any) must be served and filed within ten days of the date of that order, unless a request for an extension of time was filed under WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.14, with good cause shown why the brief had not been timely filed. As Attorney Hunter has not served and filed a respondent's brief, nor has she requested an extension of time or properly filed any response to the December 9, 2025 order, she has forfeited the right to file a brief. Accordingly,
