The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On February 17, 2026, petitioner, James E. Malone, pro se, filed a document, dated February 9, 2026, which he asks this court to accept as a timely, but nonconforming petition to review the court of appeals' decision of January 15, 2026. In his document, the petitioner also requests an additional 90 days to file a supplement to the petition for review that will make it conform to the requirements of Wis. STAT. § 809.62. Having considered the document,

IT IS ORDERED that the document dated February 9, 2026, and filed February 17, 2026 is accepted as a timely, but nonconforming petition for review; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion for leave to file a supplemental statement in support of the petition that will conform the petition to the requirements of Wis. STAT. §§ 809.62(2) and (4) is granted, in part. The supplemental statement in support must be filed with the clerk of this court by April 17, 2026. If the statement is not filed by that time, the court will consider the petition based solely on the document filed on February 17, 2026.
