The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On February 2, 2026, petitioner Leia Marie Cruz-Perez filed a pro se petition for a supervisory writ pursuant to WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.71.

IT IS ORDERED that the petition is dismissed. This court will not exercise its supervisory jurisdiction where there is an adequate alternative remedy. *See generally* WIS. STAT. § 809.71 and accompanying Judicial Council Committee's Note, 1981. In accordance with this rule, a supervisory writ petition filed in this court "shall show why it was impractical to seek the writ in the court of appeals or, if a petition had been filed in the court of appeals, the disposition made and reasons given by the court of appeals." WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.71. Ms. Cruz-Perez's petition does not fulfill this requirement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the "Emergency Motion for Supervisory and Extraordinary Relief" filed by Ms. Cruz-Perez on February 17, 2026, is dismissed as moot.
