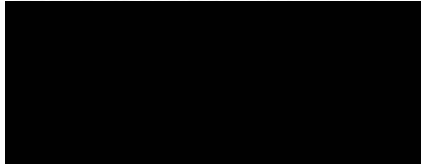

ORDER FOLLOWING SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

On February 13, 2026, at approximately 1:00 PM, a telephonic scheduling conference was held in this matter, pursuant to SCR 22.15. The Office of Lawyer Regulation appeared by Attorney Thomas J. Laitsch. The Respondent, Robert N. Meyeroff, appeared on behalf of himself.


After conferring with the participants:

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That discovery and depositions in this matter shall be completed on or before May 15, 2026.
2. Any dispositive motions shall be filed by June 19, 2026. Each dispositive motion shall be accompanied by a supporting brief. Each party shall have until July 3, 2026, to respond to the other party's motion(s).
3. Any pre-trial motions shall be filed on or before July 17, 2026. Each such motion shall be accompanied by a supporting brief. Each party shall have until July 27, 2026, to reply to the other party's motion(s).
4. The parties shall disclose to each other the names of witnesses they intend to call at a hearing, along with information necessary for the other to be able to contact any witness listed, and the anticipated evidence to be elicited from each witness, on or before March 13, 2026. If a party later believes it is necessary to call additional witnesses, they shall notify the other and provide contact information by March 27, 2026.

5. The parties shall provide to each other an exhibit list listing all exhibits the party intends to use at the hearing along with a copy of each exhibit that the party intends to use at the hearing, on or before July 10, 2026. OLR's exhibits shall be numbered beginning with number 1. Respondent's shall be numbered beginning with 200.
6. Trial briefs are not required, but if a party wishes to file one it shall be filed on or before August 5, 2026.
7. A final pre-trial conference will be held telephonically at 9:00 AM on August 12, 2026, and initiated by OLR. Any pre-trial motions filed by July 17, 2026, will be considered at this conference.
8. A hearing in this matter will be held on August 19 and 20, 2026, commencing at 9:00 AM, at the offices of Quarles & Brady LLP, Suite 2400, 411 E. Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53202. OLR shall arrange for the services of a court reporter at the hearing.
9. All filings shall be made in accordance with SCR 22.13(5).
