The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On February 12, 2026, petitioner-appellant Aman Singh filed a pro se petition to bypass the court of appeals. The court notes that “[a] party may file with the supreme court a petition to bypass the court of appeals pursuant to s. 808.05 no later than 14 days following the filing of the respondent’s brief under s. 809.19 or response.” WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.60(1). The respondent’s brief was filed on December 5, 2025, in the court of appeals, making any petition to bypass due 14 days thereafter, i.e., by December 19, 2025. Mr. Singh filed his petition to bypass on February 12, 2026—well beyond that deadline. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition to bypass is dismissed as untimely.
