
SCHEDULING ORDER

This matter involves a single issue: whether the client fee agreement used by Attorney Dahlberg violates Supreme Court ethics rules. There is no dispute as to the language of the fee agreement. After discussion with the parties, it was agreed that this matter could most efficiently be resolved upon Summary Judgment Motions.

Accordingly, each party shall file their respective motion, with supporting material and brief on or before June 26, 2026. Each party will have until July 17, 2026, to file a further brief in response to the other's June 26, 2026, filing.
