The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On April 21, 2026, this Court received numerous documents filed by Lamonte Ealy, pro se. These include: a Petition for Review; an Appendix to Support Petition for Review; a Petition for a Supervisory Writ; Memorandum in Support of Supervisory Writ; and a Petition to Bypass. The documents relate to the court of appeals' order dated March 26, 2026, which denied various request for relief from Mr. Ealy in Case No. 2026XX333, and the court of appeals' decision dated November 30, 2021, in consolidated Case Nos. 2020AP1443, 2020AP1444, and 2020AP1445, which summarily affirmed a circuit court order denying Mr. Ealy's postconviction motions in Milwaukee County Case Nos. 2013CF5263, 2013CF5567, and 2014CF2242.

All three substantive filings from Mr. Ealy in this court appear to seek the same, or substantially similar, relief. To the extent Mr. Ealy seeks review of the court of appeals' decision in Case Nos. 2020AP1443, 2020AP1444, and 2020AP1445, we note that Mr. Ealy previously filed a petition for review from the court of appeals' decision in the consolidated appeals, which petition this court denied over four years ago. *See State v. Ealy*, Nos. 202AP1443, 2020AP1444, 2020AP1445, S. Ct. Order (Mar. 16, 2022). To the extent Mr. Ealy seeks to bypass the court of appeals relating to Case No. 2026XX333, any such request is moot because the court of appeals has already issued a decision in that matter and, as such, there is nothing to "bypass." Finally, Mr. Ealy's request for supervisory relief is duplicative of the arguments and relief sought in his petition for review.

IT IS ORDERED, that all of the above filings by Lamonte Ealy, pro se, are construed as a petition for review and supporting documents related to the court of appeals' March 26, 2026 order in Case No. 2026XX333, and a decision on such petition will issue in due course.
