The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On March 11, 2026, this court issued an order that denied Natalie R. Peters' pro se petition to commence an original action, and dismissed her related "Emergency Motion for Temporary Stay of Circuit Court Proceedings."

That same day, Ms. Peters filed a document that the court construed as a supplement to her original action petition. This document was the latest in a series of supplemental filings received from Ms. Peters.

On March 12, 2026, this court issued an order stating that, "having fully considered this matter and disposed of it by order of March 11, 2026," the court would "take no action on Ms. Peters' March 11, 2026 supplemental filing. The court's review is complete and this matter is closed."

Over the ensuing weeks, Ms. Peters attempted to file additional documents, but the clerk of this court returned these documents to Ms. Peters, unfiled, for failure to comply with Wis. STAT. § (Rule) 809.801(3)(d).

On April 20, 2026, Ms. Peters filed a document titled "Notice of Declaration of Independence from Despotic Rule," along with various accompanying documents.

IT IS ORDERED that the court will take no action on Ms. Peters' April 20, 2026 filing. As this court made clear in its March 12, 2026 order, "[t]he court's review is complete and this matter is closed." The clerk of this court is directed to place any further filings from Ms. Peters in this matter into the closed file without response.
