The Court, by its Clerk and Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On April 21, 2026, petitioner-appellant, Pat Schottler, pro se, filed a document entitled "Notice of Appeal." The court has construed that document as a timely, but nonconforming petition for review of the court of appeals' decision of April 7, 2026. Petitioner-appellant, however, subsequently filed a motion for reconsideration in the court of appeals. The court takes notices that, in an order dated April 28, 2026, the court of appeals denied petitioner-appellant's motion for reconsideration. Ordinarily, pursuant to WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.62(1m)(c), the respondent-respondent, Department of Transportation, would have 14 days to file a response to the petition for review. Because the petition for review filed by petitioner-appellant is not complete, however, the court will provide petitioner-appellant with an opportunity to file a statement in support of the petition that conforms to the requirements of WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.62 and will then establish a deadline for the respondent-respondent to file a response to the petition. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that, on or before May 27, 2026, petitioner-appellant shall file a statement in support of the petition for review that conforms to the requirements of WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.62(2) and (4). If the statement in support is not filed by that time or if the statement fails to comply with the requirements of WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.62(2) and (4), the petition for review will be dismissed; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the respondent-respondent may file a response to the petition within 14 days after service of the statement in support of the petition.
