Estate of Hugh F. McCaffery, Sr. v. Garrett, L.C.#2019CV87

by the supreme court of the court of appeals' April 4, 2023 decision in this appeal. A review of the attorney records maintained by the clerk of this court reveals, however, that Hugh F. McCaffery, Jr., is not an attorney licensed to practice law in the courts of this state, and he may not represent the Estate in his own personal capacity or in his capacity as personal representative because that would constitute the unauthorized practice of law. State ex rel. Baker v. County Court of Rock County, Br. 1, 29 Wis. 2d 1, 138 N.W.2d 162 (1965); Wis. Stat. § 757.30(1) and (2); see also Jadair Inc. v. United States Fire Ins. Co., 209 Wis. 2d 187, 562 N.W.2d 401 (1997); Ditech Financial, LLC v. Estate of Stacey, 2018 WI App 18, 380 Wis. 2d 447, 909 N.W.2d 180. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for review and all motions filed to date in this court are dismissed. Mr. McCaffery is advised that the 30-day period in which a properly signed petition for review of the court of appeals' April 4, 2023 decision may be filed will expire on May 4, 2023. See Wis. Stat. § 808.10 and § (Rule) 809.62.
