No. 2026XX1291-D OFFICE OF LAWYER REGULATION V. ROBERT LEE TAYLOR

The Court, by its Commissioners, has entered the following order:

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) has filed a notice of motion and motion for summary license suspension, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 22.20, based upon Attorney Robert Lee Taylor's conviction of three counts of second-degree sexual assault, one count of misdemeanor battery, and one count of strangulation and suffocation. *State v. Taylor*, Milwaukee County Case No. 2022CF4881. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to SCR 22.20, Attorney Taylor shall show cause, in writing, to this court by July 13, 2026, why OLR's motion should not be granted and his license to practice law in Wisconsin should not be summarily suspended.
