No. 2026XX1560-D OFFICE OF LAWYER REGULATION V. MICHAEL D. HUITINK

July 23, 2026

The Court, by its Commissioners, has entered the following order:

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) has filed a motion, along with a supporting affidavit and exhibits, seeking the summary suspension of Attorney Michael D. Huitink's license to practice law in Wisconsin pursuant to SCR 22.20. The motion is based on Attorney Huitink's no contest plea to one felony count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated, causing injury. *See State v. Huitink*, Waukesha County Case No. 2025CF1155.

IT IS ORDERED that Attorney Michael D. Huitink shall show cause, in writing, to this court within 20 days of the date of this order why OLR's motion should not be granted and his license to practice law in Wisconsin should not be summarily suspended.
