The Court, by its Commissioners, has entered the following order:

The court having received a document filed by defendant-petitioner, Christopher Titus Tyra, Jr., pro se, that it construes as a motion to extend the time in which to file a petition to review the court of appeals' July 2, 2026 order denying Mr. Tyra's petition for leave to appeal a nonfinal circuit court order;

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is denied. The 30-day period in which to file a petition for review may not be enlarged. *First Wisconsin National Bank of Madison v. Nicholaou*, 87 Wis. 2d 360, 274 N.W.2d 704 (1979);

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the motion itself shall be deemed to be a timely, but nonconforming petition for review. However, a statement in support of the petition, conforming to the requirements of WIS. STAT. §§ 809.62(2) and (4), must be filed with the clerk of this court by September 8, 2026. If the statement is not filed by that time, this petition may be summarily dismissed.
