State ex rel. Grissom v. Champagne

On November 24, 2004, Terrance Grissom, *pro se*, filed a document entitled "petition for writ of certiorari" which appears to be an attempt to initiate a lawsuit against Quala Champagne, in her capacity as warden of the Columbia Correctional Institution. In it, he appears to be challenging his conviction, as well as various conduct by prison authorities that he deems wrongful. He also contends that he is in "imminent danger."

The petition fails as an improper pleading. It is virtually incomprehensible and makes only conclusory allegations as to why Mr. Grissom is entitled to relief. The court notes that it has recently referred a petition for writ of habeas corpus filed by Mr. Grissom regarding his conditions of confinement to the circuit court. See *State ex rel. McCaffrey v. Shanks*, 124 Wis. 2d 216, 232-33, 369 N.W.2d 743, 752-53 (Ct. App. 1985). Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition for writ of certiorari is dismissed.
