The Court, by its Commissioners, has entered the following order:

The Office of Lawyer Regulation (OLR) has filed a motion for summary license suspension and supporting documents, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule (SCR) 22.20, based upon Attorney Joseph M. Freier's convictions of one felony count of battery to a law enforcement officer as a repeater, one felony count of resisting an officer causing soft tissue injury as a repeater, and one misdemeanor count of operating a vehicle while intoxicated as a second offense. *State v. Freier*, Rock County Case No. 2025CF1139. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to SCR 22.20, Attorney Freier shall show cause, in writing, to this court within 20 days of the dates of this order, why OLR's motion should not be granted and his license to practice law in Wisconsin should not be summarily suspended.
