The Court, by its Commissioners, has entered the following order:

On August 11, 2026, a petition to bypass the court of appeals was filed by defendant-appellant, Michael Mario Miller, Jr., pro se. "A party may file with the supreme court a petition to bypass the court of appeals pursuant to s. 808.05 no later than 14 days following the filing of the respondent's brief under s. 809.19 or response." WIS. STAT. § (Rule) 809.60(1). The respondent's brief was filed on July 20, 2026, in the court of appeals, making any petition to bypass due within 14 days, or by August 3, 2026. Mr. Miller filed his petition to bypass on August 11, 2026—8 days after the respondent's brief was filed in the court of appeals. Upon the foregoing,

IT IS ORDERED that the petition to bypass is dismissed as untimely.
